Today, May 30 is **Peace With Justice Sunday** and one of the six second-mile special conference offerings that we support. This offering empowers United Methodists to work for peace, love, and compassion for God's children everywhere.

Next Sunday, June 6, we will be taking our **2010 Annual Conference offering** to fund leadership development in Brazil, Mozambique, and northern Virginia. The Conference goal is \$300,000.

Brazil: \$100,000 for curriculum and teacher training materials for "Shade and Fresh Water" centers and other children's centers sponsored by the Brazil Methodist Church.

Mozambique: \$100,000 for education and training for Sunday school teachers, lay preachers, and pastors in the UMC in Mozambique, which is growing rapidly and needs leadership for the hundreds of new United Methodist churches being established throughout this southeastern African nation.

Virginia: \$100,000 for job training programs at Grace Ministries, a community outreach program of the Arlington District that addresses the most pressing material and spiritual needs of low-income immigrants in northern Virginia and empowers immigrants to become community leaders.
